Monday, May 23rd 2022 Principal's Report

Acknowledgement of country

I would like to pay my respect to the Aboriginal People of Australia and related island communities and the Torres Strait Islanders as the First Peoples of this Country. I acknowledge the respective Traditional Owners on whose countries we live and work.

NAPLAN

- We have successfully completed our first fully online NAPLAN testing (with the exception of year three writing)
- I look forward to seeing the results, as online testing gives much more specific information for each student
- Thank you to Trent Perry and Elliott Duncanson for their seamless introduction of online testing (I forgot it was on some days)

Other events

We've successfully had a downplayed under 8's day, and look forward to our upcoming athletics carnival, with parent communication going home soon.

We are doing quite well in the sporting arena at the moment as well, as seen on Facebook. The new school hall is getting under way, with final design briefs etc being done for the final tender process.

Our challenge to be more environmentally friendly continues, we have our containers for change term 2 coming up, with both campuses up for the challenge. We also had our school clean up day on the Junior Campus last week, with over 2000 pieces of rubbish collected! Our printing is significantly down in the last quarter as well, as we haven't been printing lots of learning from home resources this year!

Teaching

- We are looking at the new Australian curriculum recently released.
- Decisions need to be made around 2023 or 2024 roll out.
- We are using the changes to review the systems that we use to record our curriculum, with a goal of centralising all of our curriculum and assessment for all programs, including parent portals / communication about the learning being done.

Capability

- Working with Apple on the Senior Campus to develop training based on the needs of our staff.
- Rather than a planned training session, the team from Apple are currently observing our lessons and designing training to suit our needs
- We are also investing a bit of time and money at the moment on the state wide roll out program increasing the support to students with un-verified learning difficulties that I'll discuss in a moment.

Partners

- We are partnering with our local schools to explore how they are implementing the roll out
- We are also re-energising the secondary partnership to plan working smarter together. We have discussed it for a couple of years, however, ended up in survival mode more so than any strategic mode.

Inclusion

- The roll out of Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on School Students with Disability (NCCD) has been discussed for a few years now, and is slowly coming to fruition. There isn't much information about actual process at the moment, but the idea is to better document the support needed for students with learning challenges beyond what the department currently recognises as a disability (including challenges like anxiety, dyslexia, etc)
- It doesn't mean additional funding as such, but better structures around all of the learning structures.

Wellbeing

- Wellbeing is a bit of a hot topic as we emerge from covid, still with lots of covid, and in to flu season.
- Staff are definitely burnt out and we count down to the holidays, fingers crossed, without issue.
- We are exploring 'pulse survey programs' that allow us to better gauge how students and staff are travelling with their wellbeing.
- A wellbeing session is planned for day one of term three, with a parent session as well (similar to the cyber safety talks).
- Years 5 9 attended a bullying workshop last week, as part of our continued approach to respond to bullying. Information about how the College can support parents with these topics is scheduled to be sent tonight.
- Our team attends the big course in two weeks, so I look forward to having something more meaty for the next meeting.

Performance

- 2023 enrolments have begun with invitation only at this stage, soon opening up to the existing families and then the public
- Our attendance rate sits on 89.2% for the year, just under our target of 92%.
- We don't have any new academic data to share at this stage in the year.






